I have added your name so you will receive any future e-mail messages that I send on the Part 70 rulemaking and associated guidance documents. SECY-99-147, the Commission Paper on the proposed rule, and the Staff Requirements Memorandum, can be found by clicking on "1999" and then scrolling down to SECY-99-147.

You have a choice of viewing the document in html (h), downloading a WordPerfect version (w), or getting the entire file (document plus attachments) as a zipped file (z). To see the transcript of the meeting at which the SECY paper was discussed, go back to

Also, from <http://www.nrc.gov/NRC/COMMISSION/activities.html> you can click on "Commission Meeting Schedule" to get information about planned meetings, both meetings with NRC staff and meetings with the Commission. Public staff meetings on Part 70 will be listed under NMSS.

Although its public comments period has elapsed, for information about the proposed rule, start at <http://ruleforum.LLNL.gov>

then click on "News, Information, and Contacts for Current Rulemakings." Scroll down past all the "Petition for Rulemaking" to the "Proposed Rulemaking" section. The Part 70 rulemaking is called " Proposed Rulemaking - Domestic Licensing of Special Nuclear Material; Possession of a Critical Mass of Special Nuclear Material." You could also get to the same web page by setting your browser to:

At that point, you can choose background information, current news, Rulemaking Text and Other Documents, submitted comments, and contacts.

the website for the "Draft Standard Review Plan and Guidance on Amendment to 10 CFR Part 70." These are revisions to earlier posted documents. The

The

first is a revised Standard Review Plan comment resolution table. The second is a revised Draft Standard Review Plan, dated May 11, 2000.

These documents reflect the staff consideration of some recent written comments received, and discussions at the stakeholder meeting on April 18-19. The documents can be downloaded as WordPerfect files or viewed directly as html files. (Because the documents were originally created in WordPerfect, there currently are some minor formatting problems with the html format of the SRP.)
