We have received the enclosed Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) correspondence dated May 31, 2000, transmitting the FEMA final exercise report for the March 21, 2000 Plume Exposure Pathway Exercise at the Perry Nuclear Power Plant.

No deficiencies were identified during the exercise. However, three Areas Requiring Corrective Action (ARCA) were identified.

We fully recognize that any corrective actions to be implemented may involve parties and political institutions which are not under your direct control. Nonetheless, we expect that assistance, if appropriate, will be extended.
