**DRAFT SUPPLEMENTARY CHANGES TO REVISION 8 OF  
NUREG-1021, "OPERATOR LICENSING EXAMINATION

We conducted a thorough review and concur with the proposed changes to this document, with one exception.


Section ES-401.D.1.b (para.1, last sentence), discusses "adequate documentation" of the process that the licensee used to develop the written examination outline. One of the examples of adequate documentation is "**(3) a statement that the NRC developed the examination outline.**" This example should be deleted because the licensee is not required to submit an examination outline to the NRC when the NRC develops the examination outline.
