Dear Mr. Abeyta:

This is in response to your May 18, 2000, letter (NRC000921A) to Ms. Rosetta Virgilio, Federal Preservation Officer, at the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC). Your letter expressed concerns that NRC was not planning to consult with your office in accordance with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act and 36 CFR Part 800 prior to Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) constructing an independent spent fuel storage installation (ISFSI) at the Humboldt Bay Nuclear Power Plant, Unit 3. Please be assured that subsequent to NRC's receipt and review of PG&E's ISFSI application, and prior to license issuance, NRC intends to consult with your office on any matters related to historical property preservation identified in the PG&E application. However, at this time, the staff has not received an application from PG&E for the ISFSI license.
