# ORDER (Granting Extension of Time to File Answer to Hearing Request)

The Licensee, Cabot Performance Materials, has orally moved without objection for yet another extension -- from June 30, 2000 to September 28, 2000 -- of the time within which to file its answer to the hearing request filed by the City of Reading and the Redevelopment Authority of that City in this source material license proceeding.

On the basis of the representations contained in the Licensee's last motion (see my May 30, 2000 order (unpublished)), it had been my expectation that the matter would be settled by now. In a telephone conference today, in which counsel for the Licensee and the Redevelopment Authority participated, Judge Cole and I were given, however, adequate reasons why a newly discovered question involving title to a portion of the property necessitates the sought additional extension. Accordingly, the time for the filing of the Licensee's answer is further <u>extended</u> to and including September 28, 2000.
