Dear Ms. Reed:

Pursuant to the provisions of the Privacy Act, 5 U.S.C. Sec. 552a, the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. Sec. 552, and the Electronic FOIA Law, I hereby request copies of the following documents: (1) August 21, 1997 letter from Mr. C. H. Cruse (BGE) to the Document Control Desk, regarding "Request for Review and Approval of System and Commodity Reports for License Renewal" and (2) July 9, 1998 letter from Mr. D. L. Solorio (NRC) to Mr. C. H. Cruse (BGE), regarding "Request for Additional Information for the Review of the Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant, Units 1 & 2, Commodity Report for Cables." Both of these documents are referenced in the "Response to Request for Additional Information for the Review of the Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant, Units 1 & 2, Commodity Report for Cables" dated September 17, 1998 by Charles H. Cruse (BGE).

I request a fee waiver because the information I am requesting will contribute significantly to the public's understanding of the operations of nuclear power plants and is primarily in the public interest. License renewal is still a novel issue and therefore is of great public interest. Information included in these documents will be posted on our center's website and therefore accessible to the public. Please consider that a fee waiver has been previously granted to our organization for FOIA/PA 2000-0191.

As you are aware, the FOIA requires you to release documents in segregable portions in the event they contain exempt material. For any documents or portions that you deny due to specific FOIA exemption, please provide an index itemizing and describing the documents or portions of documents withheld.

I understand I am entitled to make this request under the Freedom of Information Act, and if your agency response is not satisfactory, or if I do not hear a response in the 20 days allowed by law, I am prepared to make an administrative appeal.


If my request is denied or not fully granted, I am also prepared to make an administrative appeal. In future correspondences, please indicate to us the name of the official to whom such an appeal
