This memorandum provides the Spent Fuel Project Office's (SFPO's) assessment of the Committee to Review Generic Requirements' (CRGR's) review of the HI-STAR 100 Cask System rulemaking proposal. The SFPO staff met with CRGR on August 25, 1999 (CRGR Meeting No. 345), nine days before 10 CFR 72.214 was amended to add the HI-STAR 100 Cask System to the list of approved spent fuel storage casks.

- (1) *Staff Assessment of "Value Added" by CRGR Review:* At the meeting, the staff discussed the design and operation of the cask and the staff's related review and rulemaking activities. CRGR did not raise any issues regarding safety, backfit considerations, completeness, and consistency with Commission's policies, rules, and regulations. Also, CRGR made few comments and no recommendations. The staff indicated that the review and rulemaking process for other spent fuel storage casks would be similar to the HI-STAR 100's; therefore, a CRGR review of rulemaking proposals for other spent fuel storage casks should not be necessary. CRGR agreed.
- (2) *Staff Efforts Expended in Addressing CRGR Comments and Recommendations:* Minimal, CRGR made few comments and no recommendations.
