The Board, in its April 22, 1998 Memorandum and Order (Rulings on Standing, Contentions, Rule Waiver Petition, and Procedural/Administrative Matters), announced its decision regarding the admissibility of the participants' contentions and provided participants with the opportunity to file motions for reconsideration of the Memorandum and Order, due on or before May 4, 1998. April 22, 1998 Memorandum and Order at 120.

In its Memorandum and Order, the Board also reminded participants that requests to exceed the ten-page limit on pleadings set forth in its February 2, 1998 Memorandum and Order (Memorializing Initial Prehearing Conference Directives) must comply with the procedures described in the February 2, 1998


Order. April 22, 1998 Memorandum and Order at 165-66.

Pursuant to the Board's February 2, 1998 Order, the State motions for approval to exceed the ten-page limit in a Motion for Reconsideration of the Board's April 22, 1998 Memorandum and Order that the State will file by May 4. The State estimates that its Motion for will not exceed 20 pages.

Counsel for the NRC Staff, Castle Rock Land & Livestock, L.C., et al, Confederated Tribes of the Goshute Reservation and the Skull Valley Band of Goshutes do not object to this motion. The State has not yet received a response from counsel for the Applicant or Ohngo Gaudadeh Devia.

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
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
