STATE OF UTAH'S REQUEST FOR REVISION
OF LEAD PARTY DESIGNATION

Pursuant to LBP-98-7, the State files this request for revision to the Board's designation of lead party for the consolidated financial assurance contention.

The Board consolidated Utah Contention E, Castle Rock Contention 7 and Confederated Tribes Contention F (Financial Assurance) and designated the Confederated Tribes as the lead party for the consolidated contention. LBP-98-7 at 159. The State requests the Board designate the State as the lead party for this contention. The bulk of the consolidated Financial Assurance contention, as re-written by the Board, is derived from State Contention E. Id., Appendix A, at 1-2. In addition, the State has conferred with counsel for Castle

Rock and counsel for the Confederated Tribes of the Goshute Reservation¹ and they have no objection to the State being designated the lead party. In fact, it is their preference that the State be designated the lead.
