Subject: Termination of Senior Reactor Operator's License for Mr. Brian Dodd

Gentlemen:

I am writing to request that you terminate the Senior Reactor License of Mr. Brian Dodd (No. SOP-3776-5) effective July 1, 2000. Mr. Dodd has been on a leave of absence from Oregon State University (OSU) since September 1998 when he accepted an appointment as a Research Reactor Specialist with the International Atomic Energy Agency in Vienna. It is our understanding that when a license has been inactive for two years, license renewal is not encouraged. As his license has been inactive for almost two years now, we have decided not to renew it. However, Mr. Dodd will be returning to OSU in 2001, or 2003 if his appointment is extended, and has expressed interest in re-obtaining a Senior Reactor Operator license at that time.
