Relative to this conference, the staff should be prepared to advise the Board of its current schedules for (1) its safety evaluation report (SER) for the Private Fuel Storage, L.L.C., (PFS) facility and any planned SER



supplements (or additional staff positions on contentions) that are relevant to any pending issues in this proceeding; (2) the draft and final environmental impact statements for the PFS facility; and (3) completion of any cask-related reviews that are relevant to any pending issues in this proceeding. Further, in preparation for this telephone conference, the Board requests that the parties discuss among themselves the matter of future scheduling for the Groups I-II and Group III contentions and be prepared to provide the Board with suggestions (joint, whenever possible) on further scheduling for this proceeding, including dates for limited discovery windows; filing summary disposition motions, prefiled testimony, and in

limine motions; conducting evidentiary hearings; and filing findings of fact.

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

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
