Commonwealth Edison (ComEd) Company in Reference 1, proposed changes to Appendix A, Technical Specifications (TS), of Facility Operating License Nos. NPF-11 and NPF-18. Specifically, we proposed to change TS Section 3/4.5.1, "ECCS-Operating," Action c, and its associated Bases Section. The submittal identified that the changes were being proposed to eliminate a TS inconsistency that had the potential to require an unnecessary stopping of the Noble Metals Injection procedure if the High Pressure Core Spray (HPCS) System became inoperable.

During recent evaluations performed in preparation for the Noble Metals Injection procedure for Unit 2, it was identified that although the proposed changes would eliminate the TS inconsistency, the proposed changes would not prevent the stopping of the Noble Metals Injection procedure if the HPCS System became inoperable. Therefore, we request the withdrawal of our submittal identified in Reference 1.
