SUBJECT: INPUT TO ACKNOWLEDGMENT LETTER FOR THE PROPOSED
CORPORATE RESTRUCTURING OF DTE ENERGY COMPANY

The attached draft letter of acknowledgment represents RGEB's review of the submittal of May 31, 2000, concerning the proposed restructuring of DTE Energy Company, the parent company of Detroit Edison Company, holder of the license for Fermi 2 Nuclear Power Plant. The proposed restructuring would transfer ownership of Detroit Edison's integrated transmission facilities with voltage ratings of 120 kilovolts and above to a newly formed subsidiary of DTE Energy Company, named International Transmission Company (ITC).

We concur with the licensee's opinion that the proposed restructuring does not constitute a direct or indirect transfer of an NRC license or of any right thereunder, and thus does not require NRC approval.
