Dear Mr. Borchardt:

I am writing in response to the letter citing Notice of Violation and Proposed imposition of civil penalty dated June 29, 2000. Glendive Medical Center has previously made written responses on May 8, 24 and June 6, 2000, regarding the one apparent violation found during a routine inspection. Glendive Medical Center has taken the necessary measures to correct this situation.

Glendive Medical Center will not contest the base civil penalty of \$2,750.00. However, we would like to note that in the letter dated June 29, 2000, and signed by Ellis W. Merschoff, Regional Administrator, it indicates that in 19 instances generators were left unsecured for several hours in a hallway. This is not accurate. Generators were never left in a hallway. As is stated in the Notice of Violation, the generators were in an imaging room.

We have enclosed payment for the civil penalty of \$2,750.00. This letter is being sent certified, return receipt mail through the U.S. postal service to assure proper delivery.
