INTERNALS" (TAC NOS. MA0909 AND MA0910)

Dear Mr. Powers:

On December 31, 1997, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) issued Generic Letter (GL) 97-06, "Degradation of Steam Generator Internals." The purpose of the GL was to obtain information that would enable the staff to verify that the condition of the licensees' steam generator internals comply with and conform to the current licensing basis for their respective facilities. The staff has completed its review of licensees' responses to GL 97-06.

By letter dated April 14, 1998, you responded to GL 97-06. The staff's review of your response to the GL did not identify any concerns with the condition of the steam generator internals at the Donald C. Cook Nuclear Plant Units 1 and 2. The detailed technical basis that supports the staff's determination for all facilities will be published in a NUREG report. The expected publication date is December 2000. This completes the staff's effort on TAC Nos. MA0909 and MA0910.
