ORDER

On May 11 and 12, 2000, the Power Authority of the State of New York, Entergy Nuclear Operations, Inc., Entergy Nuclear FitzPatrick, LLC, and Entergy Nuclear Indian Point 3, LLC, filed applications seeking the Commission's approval of the transfer of the facility operating licenses for the two above-captioned facilities. On July 18, 2000, the County of Putnam, the Town of Cortlandt, and the Hendrick Hudson School District sought extensions of time, until July 31, within which to file their petitions to intervene and requests for hearing regarding these applications. In addition, the Town of Cortlandt, and the Hendrick Hudson School District requested an extension until July 31 of the deadline for filing comments (pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 2.1305). Pursuant to my authority under 10 C.F.R. § 2.772(b), I extend until July 31, 2000, the time within which these governmental entities may file their petitions, requests and/or comments.
