 PERFORMANCE REPORT  
 January 1, 2000 through June 30, 2000**

During the first performance period of 2000, the STP Nuclear Operating Company (STPNOC) Fitness for Duty (FFD) Program conducted a total of 1959 FFD screening tests that resulted in twenty-two positive test results. The positives were comprised of:

- 1 licensee employee
- 1 long-term contractor
- 20 short-term contractors of which 16 were pre-access.

The increased number of pre-access and random tests performed during the performance period resulted from the Unit 1, 1RE09, Steam Generator Replacement Outage.

STPNOC did not have any 10CFR26.73 reportable events during the performance period.
