## ORDER (Scheduling/Administrative Matters)

Upon consideration of (1) the State of Utah's (State) August 2, 2000 request for admission of late-filed contentions Utah LL through OO (relating to the NRC staff draft environmental impact statement analysis of spent fuel transportation risks); and (2) the Commission's August 1, 2000 decision in CLI-00-13, 52 NRC \_ (Aug. 1, 2000), it is

ORDERED, that party responses to the State's August 2, 2000 request for admission of late-filed contentions Utah LL through Utah OO shall be filed on or before Wednesday, August 16, 2000; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED, that on or before Monday, August 14, 2000, the parties shall provide the Board with a joint report providing a schedule for (1) the submission by applicant Private Fuel Storage, L.L.C., (PFS) of a sample service contract; and (2) an opportunity for the State to address the adequacy of the PFS sample service contract that provides for further summary disposition filings relating to Contention Utah E/Confederated Tribes F, Financial Assurance, and a hearing, see CLI-00-13, 52 NRC at \_\_ (slip op. at 15); and it is

FURTHER ORDERED, that on or before Monday, August 28, 2000, the parties shall provide the Board with a submission that discusses the impact, if any, of the Commission's decision in CLI-00-13 on the matters that currently are the subject of the parties' July 31, 2000 proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law relating to contentions Utah E/Confederated Tribes F and Utah S, Decommissioning. If a party finds it more convenient to do so, a discussion regarding any CLI-00-13 impacts, labeled as such, may be incorporated into its proposed findings response due that same date.
