Subject: Freedom of Information Act Request

Gentlemen:

Maine Yankee Atomic Power Company, pursuant to 5USC552(a)(3), requests the following information:

NRC agency records (as defined in 10CFR9.13), including printed copies of those in electronic format, associated with NMSS scheduling and review of the NAC-UMS Maine Yankee amendment review and rulemaking schedules (TAC No. L22979. Docket No. 72-1015)

In particular, Maine Yankee requests all NMSS agency records not previously provided to Maine Yankee associated with:

1. Assignment and scheduling of the "thermal" review culminating in the June 29, 2000 RAI; and reviewer, supervisor, project manager and management notes, correspondence, etc., related to the initiation, progress, status, problems, issues and completion of the "thermal" review.
2. Notes, minutes, correspondence, e-mail, etc. related to the June 13th and/or June 15th conference calls amongst NMSS, NAC and Maine Yankee, and subsequent phone conversations and management decisions associated with the propriety of the "thermal" review and resulting RAI questions.


3. The development of internal schedules, whether final, preliminary or tentative, for the NAC-UMS Maine Yankee amendment review and rulemaking activities from January, 2000 to the present, including any discussions on the basis for the schedules.
4. Notes, minutes, correspondence, e-mail, etc. associated with and resulting from the January 18, 2000 meeting amongst NMSS, NAC and Maine Yankee (and subsequent meetings and teleconferences) with respect to the issue of Maine Yankee "high burn-up fuel", through April, 2000.

We believe this request is sufficiently focused and concise to not meet any criteria for extension of time due to unusual or exceptional circumstances. Therefore, Maine Yankee requests receipt of documents within 20 days. Maine Yankee agrees to bear all search and copying costs associated with this request.
