Dear Mr. Trout:

The subject interagency agreement was closed out on September 30, 1998. However, since closeout of the IA, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) has received an invoice for \$456.53 for services that were performed by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers for NRC. Therefore, the purpose of this unilateral modification is to obligate \$456.53, in order to pay the final invoice. Accordingly, the following changes are hereby made:

Article IV - Obligation of Funds and Estimated Amount of the Interagency Agreement is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

The total estimated amount of this Agreement is \$660,039.35.

The amount presently obligated by the NRC for this Agreement is \$660,039.35.


