The purpose of this modification is to provide incremental funding in the amount of \$25,000 thereby increasing the obligated amount from \$120,000 to \$145,000. Accordingly, the task order is hereby modified as follows:

The fourth paragraph of the definitization letter is deleted in its entirety and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:

This task order obligates funds in the amount of \$145,000 of which \$128,223 represents reimbursable costs, \$4,517 represents the cost of facilities capital, and 12,260 represents the fixed fee. Accounting data for this task order modification is as follows:
