B. Core Sample Management

Sample Management Facility personnel continued processing prototype core and cuttings from the Apache Leap, Arizona, site.

C. Quality Assurance

The integrated Office of Civilian Radioactive Waste Management/Yucca Mountain Project Quality Assurance Requirements Document and the Quality Assurance Program Description were submitted for review and approval by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) on April 13, 1990. Comments were received on June 1, 1990. Comment resolution is scheduled for June 4-July 2, 1990. Resubmittal of both documents to the NRC will be on July 3, 1990.

D. Exploratory Shaft Facility (ESF)

The ESF Requirements Document is being revised to incorporate comments from the recent technical review. The document is being developed in support of Milestone YKO4M, Draft Revision of ESF Requirements. The milestone is scheduled for completion on June 29, 1990.

E. Project Planning and Control System (PACS)

The PACS Implementation Coordination meeting with PACS participant representatives was held on June 15, 1990. Attendees were provided with planning guidance for the development of the fiscal year 1991 Performance Measurement Baseline and for updating the Long-Range Plan/Integrated Project Schedule.

F. Environmental Permitting

A conference call was held with the U.S. Department of Energy/Headquarters (DOE/HQ) on June 8, 1990, to discuss their comments on the Environmental Monitoring and Mitigation Plan Progress Report. The report will be revised and resubmitted. Work also continues on revising the Floodplain/Wetlands Assessment to address DOE/HQ comments.

G. Nuclear Waste Technical Review Board (NWTRB) Meetings and Interactions

No significant interactions to report.

II. Significant Accomplishments/Information Items

Project Managers attended the Energy Systems Acquisition Advisory Briefing on June 15, 1990, in Washington, D.C.

The Project Manager, Project Office, presented a paper titled "Underground Exploration at Yucca Mountain in Nevada" at the International Symposium on Unique Underground Structures in Denver, Colorado, Wednesday, June 13, 1990.

A Technical Exchange (TE) with the NRC on Significant Faulting was held on June 12-13, 1990, in Las Vegas, Nevada. The TE included a site visit to Yucca Mountain.

The NRC Regulatory Strategy meeting, originally scheduled for May 30, 1990, has been postponed until June 25, 1990.

Project institutional staff supported the Project Office in the design and construction of a Climax Mine exhibit for the Clark County Yucca Mountain Information Office.
