Enclosed is an application for a license (XCOM1139), recently received by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, for the export of a vacuum system, sleeve assembly, collector assemblies, spare and replacement parts and other specially designed equipment and components for use in the SILEX enrichment project in Australia.

Before taking action on this request, we would appreciate your views, in accordance with established procedures and from the overall perspective of the Executive Branch, as to whether the requested export meets the applicable criteria in the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended.
