AMENDMENT TO INDEMNITY AGREEMENT NO. D-3
AMENDMENT NO. 17

Effective August 16, 2000, Indemnity Agreement No. D-3, between the National Aeronautics and Space Administration, and the Atomic Energy Commission, dated September 19, 1962, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

Item 3 - Location

The area enclosed by the Reactor Facility fence and all buildings and facilities included therein, such location being at the National Aeronautics & Space Administration's Plum Brook Research Facilities near Sandusky, Ohio. The location is further depicted in Figure 2.4, "Plot Plan of Reactor Facility," revised October 29, 1965, and transmitted with the licensee's letter of January 25, 1966, and said figure is made part of this indemnity agreement by reference.
