BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE OF TRIP:

The purpose of this meeting was to discuss the status report that the Center for Nuclear Waste Regulatory Analyses (CNWRA) had provided the Licensing Support System (LSS) Administrator (LSSA) on September 26, 1990, with regard to Task 1 (the Development of Access Protocols to LSS Technical Data) and to revise the draft charts that the CNWRA had prepared to brief the LSS Advisory Review Panel (LSSARP) on this subject, in accordance with LSSA guidance.

SUMMARY OF PERTINENT POINTS:

CNWRA representatives clarified portions of its status report, responding to LSSA questions. Messrs. Donnelly and Cameron made several suggestions for possible improvement in the briefing charts and in the general approach to the briefing, which were incorporated.

It was agreed that DOE/YMPO packaging of technical data has become a primary focus for Task 1, requiring further exploration of detail at the YMPO itself and, possibly, at one or two of the YMPO's prime contractor sites. The LSS Rule should have been more explicit with regard to the intended use of these packages in relation to the LSS, its bibliographic headers, and its needed access protocols.

IMPRESSIONS/CONCLUSIONS:

The conversation set the stage for a more informative and productive briefing of the LSSARP.

PENDING ACTIONS:

The LSSARP briefing will take place, as scheduled, on October 11, 1990.




