SUBJECT: STEAM GENERATOR OPERATIONAL ASSESSMENT, INDIAN POINT  
NUCLEAR GENERATING UNIT NO. 2 (TAC NO. MA9288)

Dear Mr. Blind:

On June 2, 2000, Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (ConEd), submitted to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) the steam generator condition monitoring and operational assessment reports for Indian Point Nuclear Generating Unit No. 2 (Indian Point 2). These reports provided information in support of ConEd's request to operate the plant for a period of time with the existing steam generators. In accordance with the actions stated in Indian Point 2 Technical Specification Table 4.13-1, "Steam Generator Tube Inspection," NRC approval was required prior to plant startup because of the results found during the last inspection. However, on August 8, 2000, ConEd informed Mr. Hubert Miller, NRC's Administrator for Region I, that a decision was made to immediately enter the steam generator replacement outage at Indian Point 2 rather than pursue a short period of operation prior to the replacement.

In light of the August 8 ConEd decision to replace the steam generators, NRC approval of the June 2 steam generator operational assessment report is not required. Therefore, the NRC has ceased its evaluation of the remaining issues in the report. To document the technical findings identified during this review to date, along with findings developed during other recent steam generator reviews, the staff is considering the inclusion of these findings in a regulatory information summary. The staff's actions under TAC No. MA9288 are closed.
