## Import License

Pursuant to the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, and Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter 1, Part 110, a license is hereby issued to the licensee designated below authorizing the import of nuclear materials and/or facilities into the United States of America in accordance with the statements and representations made by the licensee in the application referenced below. **Quantity and Type of Material:** 80,000 kilograms of depleted uranium metal and oxide in the form of machined swarf/turnings and solid cylindrical pieces; and 45,000 liters of mineral oil. The depleted uranium will be shipped in the mineral oil in order to prevent combustion. The total quantity will be imported over a four year period in individual shipments not to exceed 16,800 kilograms per shipment based on a gross weight of 20,000 kilograms for the ISO container.

**Point of Origin:** United Kingdom (British Ministry of Defense Royal Ordnance Facility)

**End Use:** For recycle of the depleted uranium and conversion for production of radiation shielding products. The mineral oil will be processed for reuse or disposal.
