I. SECY-00-0169 - Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Corp. & AMERGEN Vermont, LLC (Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Station), Docket No. 50-271-LT; Citizens Awareness Network's ("CAN") Motion to Stay the Effectiveness of NRC Staff's July 7th Order Approving License Transfer

The Commission¹ approved a Memorandum and Order which (1) denies CAN's motion to stay the effectiveness of the NRC staff's order approving the license transfer, (2) denies CAN's request for an investigation, and (3) grants CAN's motion for clarification.

¹ Section 201 of the Energy Reorganization Act, 42 U.S.C. Section 5841, provides that action of the Commission shall be determined by a "majority vote of the members present." Commissioners Diaz and McGaffigan were not present when this item was affirmed. Accordingly the formal vote of the Commission was 3-0 in favor of the decision. Commissioners Diaz and McGaffigan, however, had previously indicated that they would approve this paper and had they been present they would have affirmed their prior votes.
