SUBJECT: MEETING WITH STRATEGIC TEAMING AND RESOURCE SHARING -  
INTEGRATED REGULATORY AFFAIRS GROUP FOR THE LICENSEES  
OF CALLAWAY, COMANCHE PEAK, DIABLO CANYON, SOUTH  
TEXAS, AND WOLF CREEK (TAC NO. MA8034)

A meeting was held on Wednesday, August 16, 2000, with the NRC staff and the licensees for the Callaway Plant, Comanche Peak Steam Electric Station (Units 1 and 2), Diablo Canyon Power Plant (Units 1 and 2), South Texas Project Electric Generating Station (Units 1 and 2), and the Wolf Creek Generating Station. The meeting was held at the request of the licensees to inform the NRC about the Strategic Teaming and Resource Sharing - Integrated Regulatory Affairs Group (STARS-IRAG) formed by the licensees. The notice for the meeting was issued on July 11, 2000.

Enclosed is the list of attendees. The licensees' handouts/slides may be found in ADAMS under the accession number ML003742123. The handouts/slides consist of the following:

1. The agenda for the meeting is on page 2.
2. The background of STARS is on page 3.
3. The IRAG activities are listed on pages 4 and 5.
4. The industry activities that STARS is involved in is on page 6.
5. The goal of STARS-IRAG is addressed on pages 7 and 8.
6. A slide of projected common licensing action submittals is in the table following page 8.
7. Risk-informed inservice inspection is addressed on pages 9 through 16.

The staff did not provide a handout at the meeting. There was no discussion of any current licensing actions under staff review for any of the above facilities. The purpose of the meeting was to inform the staff of the goals and objectives of the STARS-IRAG with respect to the

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facilities. The IRAG is a group within STARS that will interact with the staff on common regulatory affairs for the facilities.

The goal of STARS-IRAG is to reduce the overall costs of licensing actions to the licensees by the sharing of licensee resources in the coordination and development of common licensing action submittals to the staff.

One of the projected common licensing action submittals for STARS is for risk-informed inservice inspection (ISI). The licensees' schedule to submit applications for applying risk-informed ISI at the facilities is December 15, 2000. The licensees stated that their plans include a coordination meeting with the staff before the submittal to allow STARS-IRAG to explain to the staff what will be requested. A tentative date of November 9, 2000, for the meeting was agreed on.

For the agenda items of NRC Project Interface, NRC Topics, and Future Activities, there was a discussion of how the traditional relationship between the individual plants and their NRC staff project manager may be modified to accommodate the STARS-IRAG role of developing common licensing action submittals. As the licensees will coordinate their efforts to minimize the resources for these submittals, they are looking for the staff and the project managers for each plant to do this also for the same goal of reducing resources needed for the staff review of the common licensing action submittals. Nothing was decided from this discussion.

The licensees completed their presentation and the meeting was closed.
