RE: FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT REQUEST; 10CFR9.23

As a result of an article contained in the New York Times, dated April 11, 2000, it came to my attention that Mr. Neil J. Aiken had reached a settlement with Pacific Gas and Electric Company. In a subsequent article in the San Luis Obispo Telegram Tribune, a similar article indicated that the settlement was to the satisfaction of both parties, and resolved all of Mr. Aiken's prior concerns.

I have also been made aware of the fact that the NRC conducted an extensive investigation into an allegation of employee discrimination of Mr. Aiken at Diablo Canyon Power Plant. I have had the opportunity to read the "final investigative report" regarding this subject, issued by the Department of Labor. However, I have not been able to review the results of the NRC investigation into this same complaint.

As a result, I as a public citizen, respectfully request a copy of the **report containing the results of the NRC investigation into employee discrimination of Neil J. Aiken**, in accordance with the provisions outlined in 10 CFR 9.23. I understand that this report is approximately 120 pages in length. I do not request any additional supporting documentation that may be available through the FOIA; only the final report.

Due to the settlement between Mr. Aiken and Pacific Gas and Electric Company, no need should exist to maintain this information exempt from public disclosure, since there are no ongoing enforcement proceedings or the possibility of a trial to resolve any differences.

I also understand through the review 10 CFR 9, that costs will be incurred to obtain a copy of this information. As the sole requester of this information, I am willing to provide the fees necessary to obtain a copy of the report.
