The purpose of this modification is to add the price to the subject contract for conducting the Root Cause/Incident Investigation Workshop in NRC's Region IV office for FY 2000. Note: The courses presented at the Region IV location are to be covered by funding currently existing under the contract and no additional funds will be added under this modification. Accordingly, the following changes are hereby made:

A. Under Section B.8, "Supplies of Services and Prices/Costs," Item 3.a., add the price for the Root Cause/Incident Investigation Workshop to be presented at NRC's Region IV office, in accordance with the contractor's proposal dated 7/18/00 as follows:
