
Dear Administrative Judges:

An error appears in the "NRC Staff's Motion for Extension of Time to File Response to 'State of Utah's Request for Admission of Late-Filed Contentions Utah LL Through OO'" which was filed earlier today. On page 2 of that document, Paragraph 5 should be corrected to read as follows (the correction is underlined):

5. Staff Counsel has contacted Counsel for the Applicant and Counsel for the State.
