The Yucca Mountain Quality Assurance Division has completed its review and evaluation of the Science Applications International Corporation/Technical & Management Support Services (SAIC/T&MSS) Quality Assurance Program Description Document (QAPD), Revision 4.

As a result, it has been determined that the proposed changes are consistent and in compliance with the Office of Civilian Radioactive Waste Management Quality Assurance Requirements Document, Revision 4, and that there has been no relaxation of the requirements. Revision 4 of the SAIC/T&MSS QAPD contains changes in organization and responsibilities with appropriate organization charts. There are also some changes in Attachment B, "Applicability of YMP APQs."
