I would like to request that the NOV administrated as per letter dated May 7, 1998 be down graded or removed because I have successfully worked twelve outages since the incident at Clinton.

Ten of these were consecutively while employed by Bartlett and the most recent two at Vermont Yankee and Farley Nuclear Power Plants with GTS Duratek, 10100 Old Columbia Rd. Columbia, MD 21046 (800-338-4487)

I would, in conclusion, submit all evaluations I have recieved supporting my successful completions of outages.

The obsticles I have had to surmountwhen applying for unescorted access to Nuclear Power Plants have been cumbersome and lengthly, requiring excessive correspondence between contractors and the plants' security offices, and myself. The efforts between Numanco and Commonwealth Edison for my clearance was so convoluted that I couldn't wait indefinitely, so I went with GTS to Vermont Yankee and Farley Nuclear. Furthermore, Virginia Power denied me access to North Anna for Barkett prior to signing on with GTS Duretec.
