We have received the enclosed Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) correspondence dated August 2, 2000, transmitting the FEMA final exercise report for the April 26, 2000 plume exposure pathway exercise at the Clinton Power Station.

Although no deficiencies were identified, one area requiring corrective action was identified by FEMA regarding the performances of State and county officials.

We fully recognize that any corrective actions to be implemented may involve parties and political institutions which are not under your direct control. Nonetheless, we expect that your assistance, if appropriate, will be extended.
