**PROPOSED REVISION TO STONE & WEBSTER'S
STANDARD NUCLEAR QUALITY ASSURANCE PROGRAM**

Enclosed is Stone & Webster's proposed 2000 Edition, Revision 0 to the Standard Nuclear Quality Assurance Program, SWSQAP 1-74A, Docket No. 99900509, for your review and approval.

Revision G of SWSQAP 1-74A, dated October 14, 1994, was previously accepted by the NRC as indicated by your letter dated November 29, 1994. Subsequent to Revision G's acceptance, restructuring and reassignment of responsibilities have taken place that are now reflected in organizational and title changes within this new revision. Additionally, Stone & Webster was recently purchased by the Shaw Group and has been incorporated in Louisiana as a Shaw Group Company, under the name of as Stone & Webster, Inc., with a subsidiary company for construction activities under the name of Stone & Webster Construction, Inc.

Therefore, we have prepared, and propose a new 2000 Edition, Revision 0 to consolidate these changes and have attached a summary of the changes made. The changes have been evaluated and it is Stone & Webster's position that no degradations to prior topical QA program commitments are contained in this revision.

(September 5, 2000)

1. Reassigned construction quality control activities from Quality Assurance to Construction Quality Control
2. Reassigned supplier source inspection activities from Quality Assurance to Procurement
3. Reorganized Quality Assurance to consolidate the Quality Engineering group and the Inspection & Test group into one Quality Assurance organization
4. Increased the scope of the program to address Title 10 Parts 71 and 72 and Title 10 Part 830.120 activities
5. Reassigned activities from the lower tier engineering organization to the Engineering organization (e.g. Section 11 Plant Operations and Services to Engineering)
6. Changed the names of some of the implementing procedure manuals to be consistent with present documents (e.g. Construction Methods Procedures Manual to Worldwide Construction Procedures Manual, Project Commercial Services & Purchasing Division Procedures to Worldwide Procurement Manual)
7. Changed the names of the S&W corporate organizations to be consistent with the present organization titles as assigned by the Shaw Group (e.g. Stone & Webster, Inc. instead of Stone & Webster Incorporated).
