The California Environmental Protection Agency, Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) requests public comments on a proposed Negative Declaration for DTSC's tentative decision to approve a Class 2 permit modification to the Interim Status Document issued to Southern California Edison, San Onofre Nuclear Power Generating Station (SONGS). The public comment period begins on September 1, 2000 and ends on October 3, 2000. Written comments must be postmarked by October 3, 2000 and sent to:

The proposed Negative Declaration is made under provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Public Resources Code, section 21080(c).

The Class 2 permit modification, which is not subject to public comment, will allow: 1) deletion of the 50 gallon/day treatment authorization, 2) handle additional waste types/codes, 3) an additional storage location, and 4) a 25 % increase to the authorized storage capacity to a total equivalent volume of 62,250 gallons.
