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NRC ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON REACTOR SAFEGUARDS TO MEET IN ROCKVILLE, MARYLAND, ON SEPTEMBER 21

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards has scheduled a meeting of its subcommittee on materials and metallurgy on September 21 in Rockville, Maryland.

The meeting, which will be open to the public, will be held in Room T-2B3 of the agency's Two White Flint North building, at 11545 Rockville Pike, starting at 8:30 a.m.

Among other items, the subcommittee will discuss the status of a technical re-evaluation project on reactor vessel pressurized thermal shock, including the development of flaw and fracture toughness distributions.
