SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO LICENSE TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

Dear Mr. Secko:

This refers to your application dated April 30, 1998, as supplemented, requesting an amendment to Materials License No. SNM-2500 to revise the Technical Specifications contained in Appendix A of the Morris Operations' license. During our September 12, 2000, telephone conversation, we discussed the utility of working this action independent of our review of the General Electric Company, Morris Operation Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation (ISFSI), SNM-2500 renewal application dated May 22, 2000. Based on our phone conversation, I understand that termination of our review of the April 30, 1998, application will have no impact on the ISFSI operational capability or compliance with the license. Furthermore, it is acceptable to evaluate the proposed change during our review of the consolidated renewal application, which also contains the proposed Technical Specification changes. Therefore, we have terminated our review of the April 30, 1998, application and closed TAC No. L22631. If your understanding is different, please notify me immediately.

This action is without prejudice to your submission of an amendment application at a future date, should you determine an operational or safety need to amend the license before we have completed our review of the renewal application.
