REQUEST FOR COMMENTS ON REVISIONS TO NRC COMMUNICATION OF "ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS: SIGNIFICANT ACTIONS RESOLVED"

TVA is pleased to provide comments on the NRC's proposal to discontinue producing NUREG-0940, "Enforcement Actions: Significant Actions Resolved," in paper form. The proposal would also eliminate distribution of approximately 2600 copies of the NUREG by mail. This proposal was announced in the *Federal Register* dated July 13, 2000 (65 Fed. Reg. 43383).

TVA supports NRC efforts to operate more efficiently and believes that it is cost-effective to provide Internet access to NUREG-0940 rather than publishing and mailing a large number of copies of the document. NUREG-0940 is a retrospective compilation of all escalated enforcement action taken during a six-month period. Although NUREG-0940 has been a useful resource, the information cited in the NUREG is now provided electronically by NRC on a more timely basis. As such, the production and mailing costs are no longer justified, given access to the same information on a more timely, significantly less expensive basis through the Internet.
