The attached issuance package for the subject regulatory guide was prepared by RES. The final guide was approved through the EDO as part of the final rulemaking on respiratory protection. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission has issued a revision to a guide in its

Regulatory Guide Series. This series has been developed to describe and make available to
the public such information as methods acceptable to the NRC staff for implementing
specific parts of the Commission's regulations, techniques used by the staff in evaluating
specific problems or postulated accidents, and data needed by the staff in its review of
applications for permits and licenses.

Revision 1 of Regulatory Guide 8.15, "Acceptable Programs for Respiratory

Protection," describes a respiratory protection program that is acceptable to the NRC staff.

The guide also provides guidance on performing evaluations to determine whether the use of respirators optimizes the sum of internal and external dose and other risks.

Comments and suggestions in connection with items for inclusion in guides currently being developed or improvements in all published guides are encouraged at any time.
