In accordance with 10CFR74.13(a)(1), TXU Electric hereby requests an alternate schedule for submittal of the semi-annual material balance report for the period ending September 30, 2000, for special nuclear material licensed under Facility Operating Licenses Nos. NFP-87 and NFP-89 for CPSES Units 1 and 2, respectively.

TXU Electric provides good cause for delaying the submittal of this report because of resource conflicts with the current Unit 2 outage, which is scheduled to begin September 30, 2000 and last approximately one month. The data for this report is not available until October 1, 2000 and, based on past experience, requires a minimum of three weeks to prepare the submittal. Outage schedule conflicts with personnel responsible for this report should no longer exist by mid-November. Therefore, TXU Electric proposes an alternate schedule of December 15, 2000 for submittal of the report.


