ESTABLISHMENT OF ATOMIC SAFETY AND LICENSING BOARD

Pursuant to delegation by the Commission dated December 29, 1972, published in the Federal Register, 37 Fed. Reg. 28,710 (1972), and Sections 2.105, 2.700, 2.702, 2.714, 2.714a, 2.717, 2.721 of the Commission's Regulations, all as amended, an Atomic Safety and Licensing Board is being established to preside over the following proceeding:

A notice of consideration of the amendment request, proposed no significant hazards consideration determination, and opportunity for hearing was published in the Federal Register at 65 Fed. Reg. 48,744, 48,754 (Aug. 9, 2000).
