Dear Mr. Chairman,

Our worst enemies could not devise and carry out a scheme that exposes our citizens in their own homes to consumer goods contaminated by "recycled" nuclear waste materials. Do we not already have an epidemic of cancers? Just reading the obituary notices of people dying of it before the end of their normal life times after excruciating suffering and at such enormous medical expense, we cannot add to it by allowing the nuclear industry to pass on their clean-up obligations to an unsuspecting public.

We must keep radio-active wastes and materials from nuclear power plants and weapon production isolated from the public and from the environment and prohibit any releases from regulatory control; prohibit radio-active materials from entering the consumer marketplace or anywhere but licensed radio-active facilities; recapture any such as have been released; and work for an international prohibition on radio-active release.
