- identify any issues not covered by the proposed MOU that may require further negotiation between the agencies or new legislative authority to address and resolve such as clarifying the authority of each agency.

- with respect to the NRC's 1991 proposed rule amending 10 CFR 31.5, identify the elements of the proposed rule that could be extracted and applied to the options discussed and described in the paper.
