Subject: Nuclear Waste Materials

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The North Davis Chamber of Commerce was advised of your proposal to accept nuclear waste materials from across the country. Davis County hosts Hill Air Force Base which provides 22,000 jobs and an economic impact on Utah of \$2.6 billion dollars. Your proposal would have a very negative impact on Hill Air Force Base due to the proposed location of your in the air logistics training base used by Hill for training missions. Your proposal fails to address the need for a low level access to the test range.

Nuclear products in that key access area will eventually eliminate access to the test range and reduce Hill's ability to provide a full service supply, repair, and training operation. Long-term, this would greatly harm Hill's ability to award a low rating in the Base Realignment and Closure process.

We very strongly ask you to abandon this proposal and follow the U.S. Government's proposal to locate waste at the YUCCA mountain site in Arizona which has been identified as a better option and funded by the Federal Government. Your immediate abandonment of the Goshuite site proposal is requested.
