**SUMMARY:** The plant entered the month operating at 100% power. On August 1, power was reduced to approximately 99% for four hours to perform control rod movement surveillance testing (as part of post-maintenance testing). Also, on August 5, power was reduced to approximately 90% for 1.75 hours to perform main turbine control valve testing (planned). The plant ended the month at 100% power.
