SUBJECT: MINUTES OF THE FEBRUARY 6, 1992 NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION/ DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY MANAGEMENT MEETING ON PRELICENSING CONSULTATION

Enclosed are the minutes of the February 6, 1992, management meeting between the staff of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission and representatives of the Department of Energy (DOE). The purpose of the meeting was to discuss topics of mutual interest regarding prelicensing consultation. Representatives of the State of Nevada (NV) and Nye County, NV also participated in the meeting. While other affected units of local government were notified of the meeting, none attended.

In the course of the meeting the NRC staff and DOE reviewed and confirmed the status of the high-level waste (HLW) repository prelicensing consultation program. Topics discussed included the prelicensing consultation program's statutory and regulatory bases, procedural agreements to implement the program, and the way that the program is conducted.

I would like to highlight several concerns related to issue resolution. The NRC staff and the representatives of DOE and NV agreed that staff-level issue resolution can be achieved during the prelicensing consultation period, but that such resolution at the staff level would not preclude the issue being raised and considered during the licensing proceedings. The NRC staff and the representatives of DOE also agreed that the existing performance allocation and issue resolution processes developed and implemented since 1985 are still in effect and that they adequately address questions related to "benefit at the margin." The NRC staff and the representatives of DOE agree that the licensee is responsible for determining and supporting decisions that enough data has been collected and

analyzed to demonstrate compliance with applicable regulatory requirements related to licensing.
