This final rule, which is voluntary, increases the information collection on licensees by creating a new reason to request a license amendment under the existing provisions of 10 CFR 50.90. The public burden for the information collection is estimated to average 609 hours per request. These existing requirements were approved by the OMB (approval number 3150-0011). The NRC staff determined that since the number of license amendment requests is relatively constant from year to year, the burden for this information collection would be insignificant and that an OMB clearance would not be required. The OMB agreed with this conclusion at the proposed rule stage.

Part 50, Appendix K, Paragraph I.A 13 hour increase. The rule offers licensees the option to use a reduced power level margin for ECCS evaluations or to maintain the current 2-percent margin. To use the option, licensees would be required to demonstrate uncertainties associated with measuring reactor thermal power.

Section 50.46 (a)(3)ii, licensees report changes to ECCS evaluations at least annually. Licensees using the revised rule option to Appendix K would include the effects of the change in the report. Not all licensees are expected to use the option. The staff assumes that 50 plants will use the option over a 2-year period, so 25 responses are expected per year.

The effort to change the annual ECCS report is minimal, estimated to be about 0.5 hours.

NRC Regulatory Issue Summary 99-06 on the voluntary submission of historical performance indicator data was issued on December 1, 1999. NRC Regulatory Issue Summary 2000-08 on the voluntary submission of quarterly performance indicator data was issued on March 29, 2000.

Although this new collection is voluntary, the estimate of industry burden is based on full participation by all power-reactor licensees which is consistent with industry feedback. The burden for the information collection is estimated at 13,860 hours (210 hours per reactor site), and a one-time start-up effort of 13,200 hours. The estimate includes only additional hours needed above those already expended by licensees to report information to the Institute of Nuclear Power Operations or to comply with other regulatory requirements (e.g., the maintenance rule, 10 CFR 50.73 reporting, etc.). The NRC anticipates that the information collection will result in a significant reduction in overall NRC burden on reactor licensees. An indication that industry shares this view is their willingness to voluntarily submit the information.

Commercial nuclear power licensees are required to report information to the NRC for events that exceed thresholds detailed in regulations such as 10 CFR 50.72, 50.73, Part 20, and Part 73. The NRC uses this information to formulate appropriate response actions to help ensure public health and safety. The NRC also performs inspections at power reactor licensees to verify that reactor facilities are operated safely and in compliance with license and regulatory requirements.

What was changed, how it affects the burden and whether it is part of a broader agency initiative. If part of a broader agency initiative, indicate the initiative.

The new information collection is part of a broader agency initiative to improve the reactor oversight process. The NRC is revising its reactor oversight process to make the process more objective, scrutable, and predictable in response to concerns expressed by congressional committees, the nuclear industry, public interest groups, as well as the NRC's own internal reviews. In mid-1998, the nuclear industry offered to voluntarily send selected performance attributes known as performance indicator (PIs) to the NRC as part of a larger effort to improve the NRC's oversight process. The new information collection allows the NRC to collect and use PI information, along with inspection information, to establish an objective basis for the assessment of licensee performance and for allocating NRC inspection resources. While the reporting of PIs will initially increase burden on licensees, this burden is expected to be more than offset by the reduction in burden associated with licensee support of NRC inspection activities. PIs will be transmitted electronically to reduce burden on licensees and the NRC.
