 TO SKULL VALLEY, UTAH!!!

I, the undersigned, are residents of the NJ corridor community - of neighborhoods and towns along the roads and rails that would be impacted by shipments of high-level radioactive waste if a radioactive waste dump is established on land owned by the Skull Valley Band of the Goshute Tribe in west of Salt Lake City, Utah.

I urge you: (1) to hold public hearings in our corridor communities regarding the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) so that we can express our concerns to you about the transport of the wastes and the hazards of the proposed site; and (2) to extend the public comment period at least 60 days.

I am concerned as a taxpayer in case of an accident requiring emergency evacuation and cleanup, the cost is estimated between 14 billion and 24 billion, under the Price Anderson we will be footing the bill for costs over \$3 billion.
